Founder's Collection honours Francisco Undurraga and his family, who founded Viña Undurraga more than 130 years ago. Viña Undurraga's entire legacy of quality, tradition, consistency and excellence is captured in a single bottle. The winery's classic viticulture and winemaking preserve the style and signature of this wine, which has been made for over 40 years. Grown on small, specially selected plots, only the best clusters of grapes are chosen for this wine.

Harvest

The grapes were hand-harvested into 12-kilo bins and then transported to the winery, where they were manually selected.

Fermentation

The grapes first underwent a pre-fermentative maceration at low temperatures (6°C) to bring out the maximum colour and aromas. Then the must was fermented in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature of between 27°C and 28°C for 15 days. Three pump-overs were carried out each day. The wine was then left in contact with its lees and skins for another 17 days to enhance its structure.

Ageing

The wine was aged for 14 months in French oak barrels, 30% of them new and the remainder were second use.

Tasting Notes

This wine is an intense, bright cherry colour. The nose is dominated by black fruit aromas like blackberries and red fruit such as cherries and raspberries, enveloped in toasty notes of tobacco and subtle hints of cedar and liquorice. In the mouth it is smooth-textured with plenty of firm, concentrated and well-integrated tannins. This is a wine with style, character and body. The finish is long and the wine has great ageing potential.
