In our constant quest to create wines with a sense of origin for the Terroir Hunter line, we sometimes find hidden gems. A set of barrels of unique and sometimes unusual wines that when blended with others achieve great balance, expression and personality.

These discoveries led us to create the T.H. Rarities wines. These are original and exceptional blends of wines that evolve and change from one vintage to the next. These are wines that represent us and give us as winemakers the ample personal creative space that we need.

Winemaking

The 2022 vintage is a blend of 70% Riesling and 30% Sauvignon Gris grown in our vineyard in the Leyda Valley.

The clusters were harvested and put into 12-kg boxes. Then they were partially destemmed by hand and put into small tanks where the maceration and alcoholic fermentation took place. They were vinified with their skins, like a red wine. The grapes were co-fermented for 15 days without temperature control or protection from oxidation. After this period, the wine remained in contact with its skins for 3 months and then it aged for 6 months in a neutral barrel. It was bottled with minimal filtration.

Winemaker's Notes

The 2022 season in Leyda was cool as usual in terms of temperatures, with plenty of sunshine. The very dry year led to very low yields, which in turn resulted in highly concentrated, distinctively ripe grapes.

Orange in colour from its fermentation and maceration with the skins, this wine offers good texture and a structure more akin to that of a red wine.

Two outstanding Leyda varieties, Riesling and Sauvignon Gris, give rise to this expressive wine with very fragrant complex, commanding aromas and floral notes of orange blossoms and white fruit.

The palate features prominent tannins, thanks to contact with the pomace, and abundant white fruit such as peach, quince and some apricot. This is a very refreshing, vertical and mineral wine that retains the delicacy and freshness of its origin. Tremendous cellaring potential.
